Overall, our attendance this week was **89.1%** Our target this year is 96%.

Every week that a class has attendance above 96% they will get a £1 credit towards a treat of their choice. This rises to £5 if the class attendance is above 98% and £10 if the whole class attendance is 100%.

The only way to earn these treats is to come to school every day. Please remember, 1 child, missing 1 day reduces the class attendance by 1.5%

Parents whose children's attendance has fallen below 93% will have either received, or will be receiving, letters in the next few days. Please remember your child should be in school every day unless they are **very ill**. All children are expected to be in school for at least 96% of the time and if attendance falls below 93% the school will begin monitoring process which could lead to legal action if attendance does not improve.


