## **Visits and Forest School**

As you may have noticed the Cadmus minibus is now the Chuckery minibus. Over the coming weeks and months, we will regularly be taking the children off site or using our school outdoor environment to extend their learning. We have 2 specialist teachers, Mr Bamber and Miss Hewitt, who are experts in Outdoor Learning and Forest School who will be leading many of the sessions.

#### Uniform

Just a reminder that our uniform policy states:

- Burgundy, sweatshirt or cardigan (preferably displaying the school's logo)
- Yellow (or white) polo shirt (preferably displaying the school's logo) or a plain white buttoned shirt
- Dark Grey or black school trousers or dark grey or black skirt or dark grey or black pinafore dress
- Burgundy Gingham summer dresses
- Grey shorts can be worn in the summer
- Grey, white or black socks or grey or black tights
- Plain black shoes suitable for school.
- Black, winter boots may be worn during bad weather but they must be appropriate and not have a heel.

## **End of school Bell**

The bell at 3:15pm is to signal that the last lesson of the day has finished and the staff should get the children ready to go home. Once this bell has rung, we will dismiss the children as quickly as we can but will **never compromise the safety** of the children by rushing this process. This does mean that, on occasions, we may keep parents waiting for a short amount of time. We ask that parents are patient during this time and do not confront staff who are there to safely dismiss all of the children

## **Late Collection Policy**

Our "Late Collection Policy" is in place and available on the school website (<a href="www.chuckeryprimary.com">www.chuckeryprimary.com</a>) but in summary says:

- We will keep the children at their normal collection point until 10 minutes after the end of the session
- We will then take them to the office
- From 3:30pm (12:00pm for morning Nursery) we will charge £5 for each five minutes. (So if a child is collected at 4:00pm there will be a charge of £30 per child)

These charges will apply in all but exceptional circumstances. If you are likely to be late collecting your child, you should ring school on

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01922 449104 to explain why you are going to be late.

#### **Attendance**

Please remember we expect your child to attend school. We have a process in place to monitor attendance which is as follows.

- You will receive a first warning letter if your child's attendance falls below 93%
- Second warning letter if attendance continues to fall to 91% and below
- First parent meeting will take place when your child's attendance falls to 92%
- Second parent meeting and home visit will take place for any child whose attendance falls to 90% or below
- If concerns continue and attendance does not improve you will be referred to the Welfare Officer who will take
- Parents/Carers to attendance panel and start legal action.
- All persistent late children will also be monitored and parent meetings will be arranged.
- If your child is going to be absent from school please call the school office to report their absence by 8.30am on

01922 449104 if we have not heard from you by 8.55am we will start to call all contact numbers that you have provided in order to gain and explanation of the absence. If we have not been able to ascertain where your child is then we may make a home visit.
