Overall, our attendance this week was 93.3%
Our target this year is 96%.

Please remember your child should be in school every day unless they are very ill. All children are expected to be in school for at least 95% of the time and if attendance falls below 93% the school will begin a monitoring process which could lead to legal action if attendance does not improve.

Year 6 have visited the National Memorial Arboretum this week as part of their study of World War 2 , where they learned about Remembrance and how events from the past have helped shape the country we have today. They explored some of the many memorials including the Armed Services Memorial and the Evacuees sculpture as well as many others. We have also made teddies as part of our study on the experiences of evacuees.



In School This Week

Reception are continuing on their Faith Trail mini adventure. The children are learning about how people celebrate Diwali, we are comparing characters from the story of Rama and Sita, we are making Diwali cards and looking at special buildings following our visit to a Hindu Temple.

Year 1 the children have been learning about the four seasons. We have gone for walks outside to spot signs of autumn. In Geography we have been identifying human and physical features in the local environment. We have created a journey map to show what we saw. In maths we have been naming 2D and 3D shapes

Year 3 have been learning all about the Stone Age. We had guests come in who brought real life artefacts from the Stone Age, around 2 million years old! We had virtual reality headsets, which let us experience life in the Stone Age to the Iron Age. We are currently learning a Stone Age dance and are bridging numbers over 10's in maths.

Year 4 have been learning more about sound. In particular, we have learnt about how the speed in which a sound wave travels changes its pitch. We have carried out science investigations to show this. We are also
