**Industrial Action By National Education Union (NEU)
Wednesday 5th July and Friday 7th July 2023**

Further to my letter dated 21st July 2023, I am writing to update you on the likely impact of the action being taken by members of the National Education Union on **Wednesday 5th July and Friday 7th July 2023**. If the action goes ahead the school will most likely be partially closed. The table below indicates which classes are likely to be open and which are likely to be closed.

The action being taken by NEU members at Chuckery is part of the ongoing campaign for a fully funded, above inflation pay increase for teachers. The NEU have stated the action is taken to ensure enough money is available to pay a fully funded increase in pay for teachers which at least matches inflation, and which begins to restore lost pay.

We fully understand the disruption this may cause and reassure parents that action is never taken lightly, and the union members feel it is in the long-term best interests of your children, so they receive a properly funded education.
