Overall, our attendance this week was 92.8%

Attendance

We are currently very worried because our school attendance is well below where it needs to be. This means many children are missing out on the learning they need. The worst day of the week is Friday! Please remember your child should be in school every day unless they are very ill. All children are expected to be in school for at least 95% of the time and if attendance falls below 93% the school will begin a monitoring process which could lead to legal action if attendance does not improve.

Christmas Dinner

Do not try and make a payment for the Christmas dinner on the normal dinner plan titled DINNER 22/23 any payments that have already been made for the 13th December have been taken off please re-book on the correct plan.**

Tickets will go on sale on Monday 28th November and Tuesday 29th November at 3.30pm in the Infant Hall. The cost of the disco will be £2.50 and will need to be paid when purchasing with the correct amount of money. If your child attends a club on a Thursday the ticket price will reduce to £1.50

School Dinner Payments

Unfortunately we are experiencing lots of late payments for school dinners you must pay for your child's dinner in advance this is so you do not accumulate debt. The office staff are having to send multiple messages to parents for payments. We appreciate that sometimes this can slip your mind. If meals are not paid for and there is persistent debt on your account the matter will go to the finance department where you will be issued with a formal letter.
