What we have been learning about this term

In Autumn 1 Nursery have been learning about 'This is me'. They have been busy talking about their family members and who lives with them. They have been looking at each other carefully to identify the similarities and differences between them through painting pictures, drawing, making models and transient art. At the beginning of this half term they learnt about Diwali and how Hindu families celebrate it.

Earlier this half term, the children were lucky enough to explore some snow, they made a snowman and threw some snowballs at Miss Edwards! Our second mini adventure was all about 'Woodlands' the children have been investigating woodland animals, their names, what they look like and their habitat. The children have been learning about the changes that occur during the Autumn time, especially to the trees and discovered there was a leaf thief! They also took part in a bare foot walk to explore their senses when reading 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt.' They have been exploring lots of natural materials that you would find in the woods. Our last mini adventure this term was 'Christmas' where we have learnt about what people do during this celebration and being part of the Early Year Christmas Production.

*Link numerals to the amounts and recognise numbers when written down.

*Understand how to keep healthy and discuss healthy and unhealthy food

*Know how to brush our teeth

*Talk about people in the community that help us

*To take care of a seed.

*To notice changes in materials.

Expressive Arts:

*Join in with songs and rhymes.

*Express ideas and feelings through making marks with different art materials.

*Join in with others during pretend play
