Walsall Holiday Activities Programme 2022

How to register for the 2022 Programme. To register your child on the programme you will need your unique code. For the 2022 programme you will only need to register once and you can then access your account throughout the year.

How to book activities?

Once you have registered for the programme you are then able to book your free activities.

When do the activities start?

The activities will take place over the summer holidays (4 weeks) see dates below;

- Monday 1st August Thursday 4th August 2022
- Monday 8th August Thursday 11th August 2022
- Monday 15th August Thursday 18th August 2022
- Monday 22nd August Thursday 25th August 2022
- What will be on offer?
- Each week over the summer holiday your child will be able choose from the following;
- 1 holiday club per week A holiday club is for 4 hours per day over 4 days a week providing a range of activities throughout each day with a healthy meal included. We have over 80 different locations across Walsall.
- Or 3 pick and mix sessions per week targeted at young people to provide a choice of activities they can engage with, this will also provide opportunities to learn specific skills, including courses in dance, music, swimming, sports coaching, youth work training, fishing, mentoring, trips etc. Once an activity has been booked for your child, you will receive an email with confirmation of their booking. If you need help booking on the Holiday Activities Programme, please get in touch with Angela Jones.

Year 6 Menu

Each year our Year 6 children get to choose the menu in the canteen for the last full week of term. A copy of the menu for next week is available from the canteen, school office or the school website.

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Attendance

Please remember we expect your child to attend school. We have a process in place to monitor attendance which is as follows.

- You will receive a first warning letter if your child's attendance falls below 93%
- Second warning letter if attendance continues to fall to 91% and below
- First parent meeting will take place when your child's attendance falls to 92%
- Second parent meeting and home visit will take place for any child whose attendance falls to 90% or below
- If concerns continue and attendance does not improve you will be referred to the Welfare Officer who will take
- Parents/Carers to attendance panel and start legal action.
- All persistent late children will also be monitored and parent meetings will be arranged.
- If your child is going to be absent from school please call the school office to report their absence by 8.30am on 01922 449104 if we have not heard from you by 8.55am we will start to call all contact numbers that you have provided in order to gain an explanation of the absence. If we still have not been able to ascertain where your child is then we may make a home visit.
