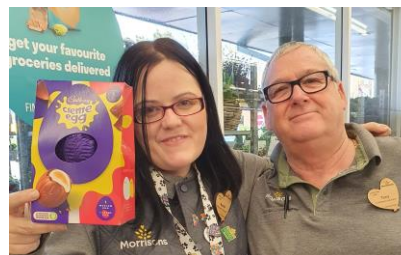

### What's happening in School!

- Nursery have been reading the story of "Mog and the V-E-T". The children have enjoyed pretending to be vets and looking after the cuddly toy animals in the classroom. We've also had a great time mixing colours and finding out how

to make new colours at the mixing station

- **Reception** This week the children have been working together to make enclosures for the animals that we saw at the zoo
- **Year 1** have continued learning more about our country, including our capital city London and our city Walsall. We are writing a letter to Paddington Bear, who lives in London, because he wants to visit Walsall.
- **Year 3** Mini-adventure is farming. We have enjoyed our farm visit to Aarta Organics this week where the children harvested leeks and radish. We created an advert for our soup. Next week we will be creating our own soup from the vegetables we collected
- **Year 4** have been learning about Sicily because we want to persuade holiday makers to visit. We have been using maps to find out where Sicily is in the world and how the shape of the country differs from others. We have also been exploring the human and physical features of Sicily
- **Year 5** will be starting a new mini-adventure and they will be continuing with their maths learning journey about angles. Year 5 will also be presenting an assembly to Phase 3 about religions and respect in Walsall
- **Year 6** have been working hard to continue converting fractions, decimals and percentages. We have created some textured and coloured art work based on The Battle of Hastings. Next week we will be moving on to look at Free will and determinism
