

Part B: Review of outcomes in the previous academic year

Pupil premium strategy outcomes

This details the impact that our pupil premium activity had on pupils in the 2023 to 2024 academic year.

KS2 maths outcomes in 2023/24 show the percentage achieving expected standard is in line with national but a decline compared to school's previous attainment.

2021/22	50% (16.7% GDS)	Attainment in maths remained the same for both groups as in 2023: 59% for disadvantaged pupils and 79% for other pupils.

KS1 maths outcomes in 2023/24 show that understanding of number presents an issue for this cohort moving into KS2.

KS2 writing outcomes in 2023/24 show that percentage of disadvantaged pupils continue to make good progress in writing and therefore the gap with national outcomes is reduced.

2021/22	41.7%	In writing, national attainment for disadvantaged pupils stayed the same as the previous year at 58%.

KS2 reading outcomes in 2023/24 show the percentage achieving expected standard is in line with national but a decline compared to school's previous attainment.
