#### **Welcome Back**

# **Late Collection Policy**

Our "Late Collection Policy" is in place and available on the school website (<u>www.chuckeryprimary.com</u>) but in summary says:

- We will keep the children at their normal collection point until 10 minutes after the end of the session
- We will then take them to the office
- From 3:40pm (12:00pm for morning Nursery) we will charge £5 for each five minutes. (So if a child is collected at 4:00pm there will be a charge of £20 per child)

These charges will apply in all but exceptional circumstances. If you are likely to be late collecting your child, you should ring school on 01922 449104 to explain why you are going to be late.

We have had to introduce the policy because we regularly have a number of children who are collected long after their school day has ended and then have to find staff who can look after them.

# **Covid 19 Symptoms**

You should only book a test if your child has any of these 3 coronavirus symptoms:

- A high temperature: any new high temperature where your child feels hot to touch on their chest or back (you do not need to measure the temperature).
- 2. A new continuous cough: coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours.
- A loss of, or change in, sense of smell or taste: a noticeable loss of smell or taste or things smell and taste different to normal.

If you are unsure about whether to get a test, please check the <u>official list of symptoms on the</u> <u>NHS website</u>, which is reviewed regularly.

## **New Covid-19 Isolation rules**

If you test positive for Covid-19 stay at home and self-isolate do not go to work, school, or public areas and do not use public transport or taxis. From 16<sup>th</sup> August 2021, if you are fully vaccinated or aged under 18 years and 6 months, you will not be required to self-isolate if you live in the same household as someone with COVID-19 unless you have symptoms.

## **Non-Covid Illnesses**

Children will still get colds and other seasonal illnesses that have nothing to do with Covid-19.

We ask that parents make sensible decisions about sending their children to school, keeping them at home when they are ill but ensuring they are in school whenever they can be. Please note, where attendance falls below 93% the Education Welfare Officer will become involved whether we have had reasons or not.
