


Chuckery Primary School Year 4 Newsletter Spring Term 2024

What have we done this term to make us feel Proud?



The children continue to make fantastic progress in their multiplication tables. They shown resilience and perseverance when it comes to trying new strategies to help them remember. The children have also shown resilience during our residential trip. They were im-

mersed in activities that they
were unfamiliar with but threw

themselves into it and learnt valuable skills such as team work, communication and independence. The children have also learned valuable skills during our fire safety session, where fire fighters came into school to help the children identify risks and react appropriately to a fire.





What we have been learning about this term

- <u>Digestion System</u> Through a very messy activity, the classes enjoyed finding out the names and the functions of different parts of the digestive system including names of teeth.
- Sound— The classes experimented with strings and cups to investigate how sound travels. They also looked at pitch and volume on a home made guitar.
- Reasons to care The classes researched Mother Teresa and Ghandi to find out how they became inspirational people and how their influence has impacted the world today.
- States of matter We changed states of matter through melting, freezing and boiling.
 We then linked this to the water cycle and discovered how gases and liquids play a part in it.
- Romans We looked at how Boudicca stood up for equality and her battle cry to persuade the people of the Iceni tribe to join her and stand against the Romans. We found out why the Romans wanted to invade Britain and Julius Caeser's failed attempt to invade.
