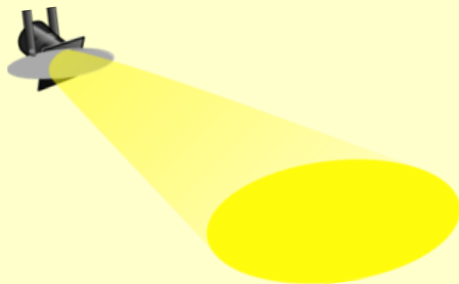


SAFEGUARDING SPOTLIGHT
