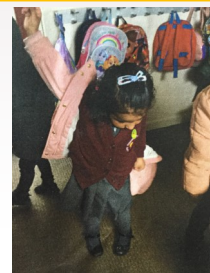

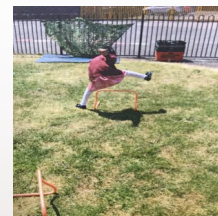


What have we done this term to make us feel Proud?

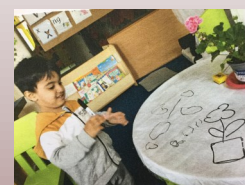

What we have been learning about this term

In summer 1 nursery have been learning about food and where it comes from. They have been busy observing plants and how they grow. In the forest area the children planted seeds with Mr Bamber by digging, planting and watering them. The children also planted a bean and took this home share with their families.



This half term the children have been very excited about the beach mini adventure and have been looking at what we find on the beach. We learnt about sea animals and plants and food you would eat if you visited a beach. The children talked about having ice-lollies on hot days and pretended they were at the beach whilst eating fish and chips.



What we will be learning about in the autumn term.

The mini-adventures your child will be covering are:

- **Homes**
- **Faith Trail**

Maths: Number: Matching and sorting, comparing amounts, representing number 1,2 & 3, comparing numbers 1,2 & 3, composition of numbers 1,2 & 3, representing numbers to 5, one more and one less.

Measuring Shape and Spatial Thinking: Comparing size, mass & capacity, exploring pattern, circles and triangles, positional language, shapes with 4 sides, time.

English:

We will be: Orally rehearsing the story of the 'Three Little Pigs' and looking at non-fictional books to identify different homes to draw and write about. In the Faith trail mini adventure the children will be writing instructions for a chocolate cake.

Add other subjects:

Understanding the World: Local walks to understand what's in my area eg the park, the mosque etc. Investigating different materials to build houses with.

Expressive Arts & Design: Drawing, colour mixing and role playing.
